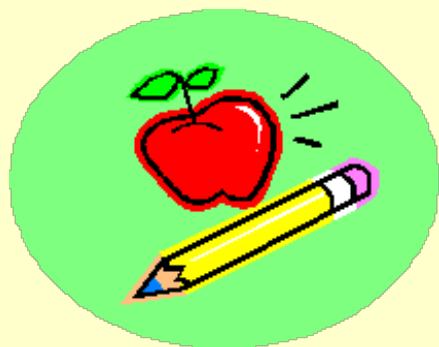
Director's Dialog
