



2017-18 DRESS CODE

1. Students must wear:

- a. White Center Academy Polo Shirt.
- b. Navy Blue Center Academy Polo Shirt.
- c. Red Center Academy Polo Shirt.
- d. Center Academy Sweatshirt or jacket

2. Students must wear Khaki, Navy Blue or Black Pants only:

- a. Shorts and skirts – mid-thigh, knee length, Bermuda
- b. Capri's

3. Students may wear jean pants or appropriate length shorts on Fridays Only.

On days designated as a non-uniform day, students must still wear school appropriate approved attire.

All clothing must be in clean serviceable condition (**no rips, tears, frays, and holes**) and must be to size, covering midriff and no undergarments exposed at any time. Shorts must be of sufficient length to adequately fit, **mid-thigh and longer**. No form-fitting pants, such as yoga pants, jeggings, leggings, spandex, workout pants, or stretchy material. **Sweatshirts and jackets worn as a shirt during the day must be a Center Academy logo one.** Flip flops, slides, heeie shoes, open back shoes, high-heeled shoes, slippers are not permitted.

Jewelry Standards: No visible permanent or temporary tattoos are permitted. No visible body piercing including eyebrows, lips, nose etc... Ears ONLY! Jewelry must not be excessive in length, number or size. No other visible body art may be worn when on school property or at any school sponsored events. No hats, sunglasses, glitter, face or body paint.

Hair Standards: All hair and make-up must be in good taste. Hair may not be bleached or dyed an odd (non-natural) color and must be styled out of the eyes. No patterns or shaved heads. No facial hair, "porkchop" or long sideburns.

Purse and book bag Standards: Purses, book bags and backpacks must be placed under the student's desk or in another appropriate place.

Failure to comply with the dress code in any way will result in disciplinary consequences.

CONSEQUENCES FOR STUDENT BEING OUT OF UNIFORM:

1. **First Violation:** Reminder notice will be given to student and for parent to sign and return
2. **Second Violation:** Student is sent to office. Parent will be called to be informed of dress code violation
3. **Third Violation:** Student is sent to office. Parent will be called to be notified that student has been removed from class and will remain out of class until the end of the day or until a parent can bring appropriate clothing
4. **Fourth Violation:** Parent called, one day in-school suspension and parent conference
5. **Fifth Violation:** One day out – of- school suspension and parent conference
